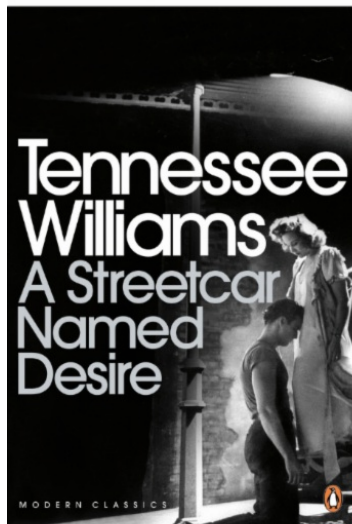

Meet Dr. Gary M Ciepluch

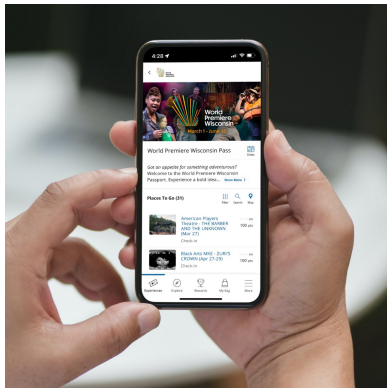
Gary joined the board in August 2022 bringing a background in the Arts as an active musician, conductor and performer.

Prior to his retirement and permanent move to Door County in 2016, he was the Director of Winds and Bands at Case Western Reserve University and the Cleveland Institute of Music. In 2016 he was awarded the Ohio Music Educator of the Year as the founder of the Cleveland Youth Wind Symphonies.

As a clarinetist, he participates in the Peninsula Symphonic Band, and is cofounder with flautist Kaira Rouer of the Do Co Chamber Winds. Gary continues to be a guest conductor, present workshops and adjudicate throughout the United States.
