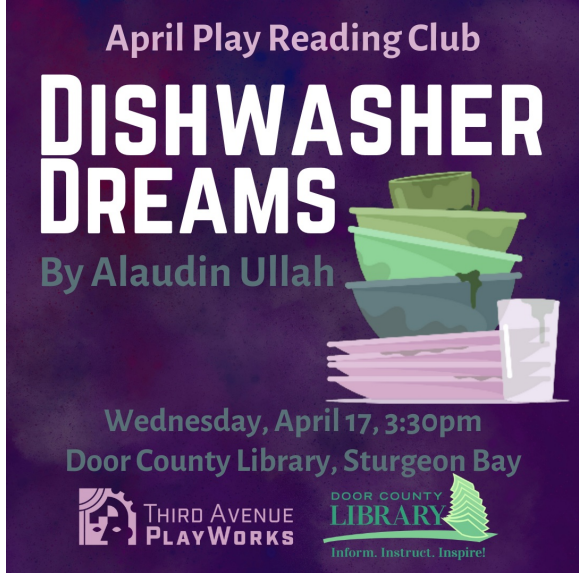

Season Launch Recap


