Want to Live Longer? Get Cultured

Did you know that a trip to the theater can lower your risk of dying?

We have known for a long time that exposure to the arts increases educational attainment for children and students, but there is new research proving the positive effect of the arts on our health. A 2019 study published in the British Medical Journal reported that for adults aged 50 and above, attending artistic or cultural performances once or twice a year lowered their risk of dying by 14%. People who went every couple of months lowered their risk of death by 31%. That's incredible!

A 2021 study in the U.S. produced similar results, showing that adults aged 65 and above who engaged with the arts had significantly lower rates of mortality.

While there are surely many reasons for these findings, at the core is the struggle against social isolation, which


